

### Senior Paper or Project Contract

The Senior Paper or Project, English 4990, is a one-credit course. Students contract with a faculty member in whose 3-credit, 4000-level course the student has enrolled for the semester. The scope of the agreed upon project must go substantially beyond the requirements for the 4000 course and must relate to that 4000-level course's content. The project may consist of a scholarly research paper, creative nonfiction essay, or an original research project. It will normally replace the most significant assignment of the course. The Senior Paper or Project will be filed in the student's permanent record in the Department of English archives.
