
- 1. Research/Scholarship/Creative Activity (these are not listed in order of priority)
 - a. Authorship of a book(s) based on original research published through a peerreview process. If the book(s) are published under an organization's name rather than the faculty author's name, the faculty must provide evidence of authorship. Scholarly publishing houses are preferable, yet the publisher's quality and reputation are considered.
 - b. Authorship of a chapter(s) in an edited book based on original research published through a peer-review process.
 - c. Authorship of an article(s) in a peer reviewed journal of national or international reputation based on original research.
 - d. Authorship of scholarly monographs that appear as technical publications of government agencies or cultural institutions that have a national or international significance.




