    - x Does my area have a charging station for my laptop?
    - x Are background noises limited?
- x Order your MavCARD
  - o Your MavCARD is your official university ID card. It is essential for all students. You will need it for:
    - x Proof of identity for accessing student services and class attendance
    - x Accessing Health Services and Campus Recreation
    - x Receiving discounts at on-campus dining locations
    - x Free access to athletic and other campus events
