

Pillen kicks off ‘6 Regions, One Nebraska’ in North Platte

The three-year economic development effort that aims to build cooperation and relationships within the state’s six community college regions in growing their economies and populations, Gov. Jim Pillen said.

Gov. Jim Pillen on Tuesday made North Platte the launching point for a new economic development initiative meant to nudge all Nebraskans to work together for statewide growth.

The governor led a morning press conference at North Platte Community College’s North Campus announcing “6 Regions, One Nebraska,” a three-year effort that aims to build cooperation and relationships within the state’s six community college regions.

It was followed by the initial Mid-Plains Region meeting of some 80 community leaders within the 18-county Mid-Plains Community
