

FERPA – AUTHORIZATION TO RELEASE STUDENT INFORMATION

For the University of Nebraska at Omaha (UNO) to release information to a parent, the high school student must sign the authorization to release student information.

In compliance with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) and university policy, this form requires written and dated consent from UNO students before

disclosing academic and financial information with parents or other third parties. This form must be filed by the student to share FERPA rights once a student reaches the age of 18 or begins attending classes at UNO.
